Things To Ponder:

- In His 'undoing' of death, Christ proves that He – not sin, not death – is the true victor and has power over sin and death.
- If Christ's bones were still in that tomb – it would mean God's wrath was not satisfied, and we would still stand guilty before God. We would be responsible for our own sin.
- When all other alternatives are exhausted, and there are no objections left, there is simply this truth: Jesus has defeated sin. Jesus has conquered death. And for all who would turn from sin and trust in Him, Jesus offers resurrection and life.
